


Notes:

- 1. In order to benefit the most from Tyrannus Online Seminary, students are expected to (a) have at least a reliable laptop with a camera; (b) access to a stable internet connectivity; and (c) a study-corner free from distractions.
- 2. Students signing up for any courses must get for yourself a digital copy of the latest Student Handbook. It is revised annually.
- 3. The Courses are divided into Foundation, Core, and Electives. Foundation courses are compulsory courses. Foundation and Core courses must constitute at least 70% of the total courses.
- 4. Each of the Course offered is 2 Credit Hours, unless stated otherwise.
- 5. The Course will commence with a minimum of 10 students signing up.
- 6. A Student is expected to finish 40 Cr. Hrs. to graduate with a Certificate. Students with a Cumulative Grade Point Average (CGPA) of 2.5 and above may continue to finish another 40 Cr. Hrs. to qualify to graduate with a Diploma; and then yet another 40 Cr. Hrs. to complete the Bachelor of Theology.
- 7. Students must plan their studies with the Dean or the local Education Coordinator.
- 8. Those signing up as Mature Students must write to the Dean for exemptions to Credit Hours. This applies to the students signing up for Bachelor of Theology degree.

Fees

- 1. There is a one-time Registration fee of RM100. This applies to students registering in 2024 and thereafter.
- 2. The Course fee is RM150 per Credit Hours; or RM300 per 2 Credit Hours. Students who wish to audit a Course, the fee is RM180.
- 3. There is a discounted fee of RM100 per Credit Hour (or RM200 per 2 Credit Hours) available for Students who wish to pay for 40 Cr. Hrs in one payment. That will amount to RM4,000.
- 4. Fees paid are not refundable, but Students are allowed to transfer the fee to do other Courses.
- 5. Fees are expected to be paid before the commencement of the Course. There will be a surcharge of RM50 for any late payment.
- *Students who are keeping up with the expected CGPA and are facing difficulties in paying fees may write to the Principal for help from the Bursary.



08 Assurance and Judgment


It is the privilege of all who through faith in Jesus Christ to be assured of their salvation; and that they will be presented as faultless before God on Judgment Day.
